Tuesday 21st January 2014 9.30am - 3.00pm, The Octagon, Walker Street, Hull. Food for Thought - Hull, how can we do it better together?

This one day conference is for organisations in Hull to come together to address food poverty and the issues surrounding it.

It will be an opportunity for organisations who work with food, and with people in food poverty to.

- Learn from each other and find out what is currently available both around crisis food provision in Hull also crisis prevention and awareness projects
- Challenge their own and other's assumptions about food poverty
- Help set out what the future food priorities are for the people of Hull

and the organisations that support them

- Look at the potential for collaboration, sharing information and organisational support

The day will be participatory, with lots of time for discussion and questions and will be chaired by the Right Reverend Richard Frith, Bishop of Hull. The day will also include presentations and input from a range of people, including:

Hull Advice Service, Trussell Trust, A local independent crisis food provider, Fareshare, Can Cook social enterprise from Liverpool (to be confirmed)

There will also be an opportunity for organisations to share information about their own services in a market place area.
