Fairtrade. I have received a letter from the One World Shop in Waltham Street which supplies the goods for the Fairtrade Stall and church tea, coffee and sugar. They wish to thank us very much for our support. In their last financial year we have managed to sell £422.20 worth of products.

Buying from small Fairtrade shops makes a huge difference. Recent research by the Independent Retailers Association has shown that 70p in every £1 spent at an independent shop stays in the local economy compared to 14p in every £1 spent in a national chain!
