Hi everyone, just to update you on what is happening at Live @ Home, and how we are endeavouring to provide a happy and supportive service to older people in our community. Lynne our manager and all our members are happily settling into the new premises on Calvert Lane/ Priors roundabout. It is in a prominent position and there has been a lot of passing interest. Most importantly it is easily accessible for all our members, whatever mobility problems they may have. We have also been able to increase our activities as we now have the space and availability to offer a wider programme of events. The core of our work though, is giving support to people on a one

to one basis in their homes. A visit once a week can make such a difference to an elderly person's life. As the lady who I support says 'Live @ Home has been a life saver and has made such a difference to my life'. When you hear something like that you know that the giving of those few hours a week may be a small thing on your behalf, but it is so much more for the person you are visiting. Because we are steadily growing both in members and activities, we have recently appointed an assistant manager – Anne Marie, on a part time basis. This enables Lynne to concentrate more on the never-ending quest for funding. Though MHA provide a core basis of money for various activities we provide, we have to match fund whatever they give us and pay for our manager and assistant as well, which is a job in itself!
