Food allergies. From December 13 December 2014 the law changes and food outlets will need to provide information to customers about allergenic ingredients in the food being served. This will apply to Ignition Coffee and to our regular

Wednesday meals service at the Lunch Club but other events at Church where food is served may arguably also be covered by this change in the law. This could include things like buffets, Alpha meals and any other one-off events. It is therefore important that everyone who helps with preparing and serving food on Church premises is acquainted with the basic information required to comply with the law. There is a leaflet and we will have copies available for those that need them. This is not something to be particularly worried about, but we have arranged for Gill Mowlem, the Manager at Ignition Coffee to come along to the next meeting for those who help with the Lunch Club to give some basic training on this subject. It will not take long but if anyone feels the need to avail themselves of this opportunity, they would be welcome to join us at 2 pm on Thursday 11 December in the Church Parlour. If you are intending to come and are not part of the usual Lunch Club team, it would be helpful if you could let me know in advance. Steve Saunders
