Letter to the Circuit Churches from Liane Kensett. "Thank you for your kind interest in how my ministry journey is progressing. I have been awaiting a letter from the President of Conference before officially letting everyone know what I am doing from September.

Having completed my Pre-Ordination training at York St John last summer, we decided as a family that it was not a good time to become itinerant. I have spent this past year as a Probationer Deacon without appointment, discerning what the best way forward is both for myself, and my family. During this year I have had the privilege of working alongside Anna Hembury and starting Orts; a sewing community on the Boulevard, and working at Selby Street building up "Create"; a creative and welcoming space. After much deliberation and prayer I have resigned from the Diaconal Order, and will be concentrating on my ministry here, as part of the Hull Centre and West Circuit. As a Local Circuit Pastor I will offer pastoral support in a number of churches across the circuit, and I will continue to invest in creative expressions of faith and community, based at Selby Street and in the Hessle Road area. Thank you again for your interest and support, and I look forward to celebrating signs of the Kingdom of God here on earth, as I work alongside you in the mission we are all called to.
