Solar Panels We are looking into the possibility of installing some Solar PV panels on our Church roof. This appears to be an excellent investment opportunity as it is possible to generate for the Church an income from feeding surplus electrical power into the grid as well as drastically reducing our own electricity costs. No final decision has yet been taken but we are exploring whether any of our people would be willing to enter into an interest free loan agreement with the Church, repayable over 5 years. **Anyone willing to consider this possibility is asked to contact me for further information before the Church Council on the 22nd.** Any expression of interest would, at this stage, obviously be entirely without commitment.
