This appears to be an excellent investment opportunity as it is possible to generate for the Church an income from feeding surplus electrical power into the grid as well as drastically reducing our own electricity costs. No final decision has yet been taken but we are exploring whether any of our people would be willing to enter into an interest free loan agreement with the Church, repayable over 5 years.
