Ignition Project - Exciting News!

Our architects, Ingleby and Hobson, have just produced a new feasibility study for us, showing how we might redevelop the premises behind the Church. By today, we hope to have on display the relevant drawings and they will be left in Church until after Sunday 17 July for inspection and scrutiny. Jonathan Hobson himself will be coming to Church on Thursday 14 July to present his ideas to an open meeting and there will be a 'questions and answers' session. After that, the 'Ignition Dream Team' and the Leadership Team will consider comments from anyone who cares to make them so that we can proceed to make any appropriate amendments and come up with a budget to enable us to secure the financial support we will need, and seek the necessary approvals from the various funders involved, and the local authority's Planning Department. Please take the time to have a good look at the drawings and, if you can, do come along to the open meeting on 14 July. Steve Saunders.
