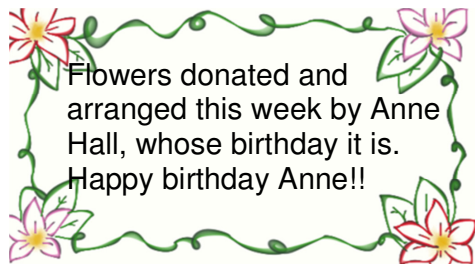
**Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2.30pm until 3.30pm. How to Use Your Ipad (and other technology!).** See noticeboard for details.
