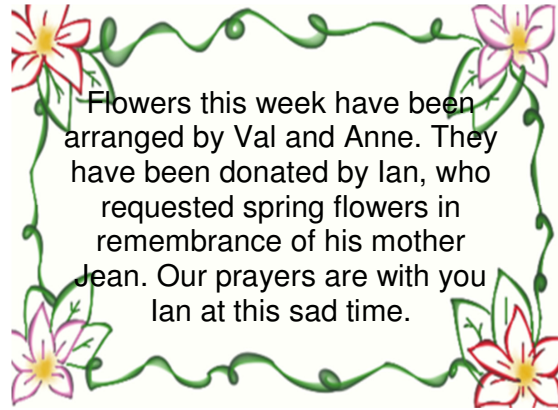
THIS WEEKS EVENTS
